Mature Prior Learning Assessment and Recognition (PLAR)

Grade 9/10 PLAR may be for you if you have fewer than 16 grade 9 and 10 credits. If you are missing any of the credits listed in the chart, then you will need to write an assessment. If you are missing other grade 9 and 10 credits, speak with your guidance counsellor.

The maximum number of grade 9 and 10 credits you could be granted is 16.

Grade 11/12 PLAR may be for you if you are in your grade 12 year and won't have enough credits to earn your Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD).

You may earn credits through the grade 11/12 equivalency or challenge process.

Mature students are still required to earn Grade 11 English, Grade 12 English and/or Literacy Course credit, Grade 11 or 12 Math and one additional senior level credit.

Graduation can be closer than you think!
